Small Group Questions/Discussions

Read v1. Fear is something that can easily overtake us. How does fear rob us of our joy? What generally causes you fear and worry? How do you overcome this crippling emotion? How has fear changed for you as you've grown older? Has maturity of faith enabled you to live with more courage?

Read v2. The writer reminds us of God's limitless power demonstrated in creation. Is this truth prominent in your thinking? What can it do to our fear? What other promises in God's Word enable you to win this battle?

Read v3-4. Put these two verses into your own words. Why do we sometimes feel like God is "sleeping"? How then do we reconcile in our minds the truth in these verses? How does it help us win over our anxiety and fear?

Read v5-6. Why is the sun and moon a cause of concern to those reading this psalm? How does this relate to us today? God is both our help and our hope. Does this mean God will always "fix" the problem at hand? Is hope available to us in other ways? Why does such faith draw us closer to God? Share a time when difficulty softened your heart towards God and grew your faith.
